FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK.

SUNDAY 26TH NOVEMBER — SATURDAY 2ND DECEMBER, 2023.

THE THEME: SAINTS AND SINNERS

THE TEXT: MATTHEW 13:24 - 30

Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away. When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared. "The owner's servants came to him and said, Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?" "An enemy did this," he replied. "The servants asked him," "Do you want us to go and pull them up?" "No," he answered, "because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn."

In our text above, it is evident that God did not introduce evil into the world, but the enemy of God did; especially by introducing sin, disease and death in God's creation.

Jesus precisely says "The enemy planted weeds among the wheat". The workers proposed to get rid of the weeds before the weeds could ruin what they had worked so hard to sow. But the master rejected the idea and proposal. He rather preferred and instructed the workers to let both the weeds and the whear grow too scher until the harvest season has arrived.

But surprisingly before the harvest, it is certain that both the weeds and the wheat will enjoy the same treatment. The disciples of Christ wanted to know why the weeds were not to be pulled, they asked Jesus to explain the meaning of the weeds in the

After all, why was it so wrong to remove the weeds so as to protect the wheat. The answer that Jesus provides amazes all. For the gospel of Jesus Christ is not about the eradication of evil but about the cultivation of Life eternal through Him.

Therefore, the weeds and all that is evil in the world are just a temporary annoyance of the enemy and distraction to what God is doing in our world. But No doubt at the end, the weeds will be burnt with the fire of destruction but the wheat will be kept

May we gain wisdom to focus on God rather than paying attention to the noise of the enemy in the world in Jesus name.
