FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK.

THE WEEKLY MEDITATION.

SUNDAY 17TH — SATURDAY 23RD DECEMBER, 2023.

THEME: SIGNS OF THE END

THE TEXT: MATTHEW 16:1-12

Then the Pharisees and Sadducees came, and testing Him asked that He would show them a sign from heaven. He answered and said to them, "When it is evening you say, '[It will be] fair weather, for the sky is red'; "and in the morning, '[It will be] foul weather today, for the sky is red and threatening.' Hypocrites! You know how to discern the face of the sky, but you cannot [discern] the signs of the times. "A wicked and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and no sign shall be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah." And He left them and departed. Now when His disciples had come to the other side, they had forgotten to take bread. Then Jesus said to them, "Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees." And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "[It is] because we have taken no bread." But Jesus, being aware of [it,] said to them, "O you of little faith, why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread? "Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up? "Nor the seven loaves of the four thousand and how many large baskets you took up? "How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread? -- [but] to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees." Then they understood that He did not tell [them] to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees. (NKJV).

"Many have been sick and were diagnosed with cancer."

And once the doctors concluded that they should be taken home because their best have been tried with no positive response, the suggestion comes to the mind of the people around, that the end has come for those patients. No doubt the physical reality is that they are at that point close to their 'last days'; one thing that must in such situations be uppermost in our hearts is to 'Go and ensure their salvation". We are to pray with them and also preach to them so that if the lord will not heal them through the prayer, He will accept them home if they surrender to Christ after the preaching.

The Pharisees and Sadducees knew how to interpret "the appearance of the sky", but could not interpret the signs of the times (v.3). In a sense, Jesus was disappointed that visitation of Israel.

We are expected to be like the sons of Issachar who understood the signs of the times and knew what Israel ought to do. A proper understanding of the times we are living in should tell us that we are in the last days. This should come with a sense of responsibility in relation to the gospel. For one, there should be a higher sense of urgency in careful with our own lives, knowing to reach the unsaved. Second, we should be more love of many shall wax cold. Are you getting cold? May we be saved at the end at all cost in Jesus name.
