THE WEEKLY MEDITATION.

SUNDAY 25TH FEBRUARY - SATURDAY 2ND MARCH, 2024.

THEME: POWER AND VALUE OF WORDS (PART 2)

THE TEXT: JOHN 1:1

"Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap."

Words are seeds

If you sow the right words into your life and future, they'll produce the right harvest. Steer your life in God's direction with the right words. "You can't keep speaking negatively and expect to have an excellent life".

Words release power

It is written in Proverbs 15:4: "A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit." "A wholesome tongue is one that speaks life, health, healing, righteousness, and abundance". "The most potent force in the universe is the force of words. Through them, God created the entire world; He framed everything with His words and lets us know we can do the same. Words release spirit-power."

Speaking words that are inconsistent with the Gospel damages our spirit, our words direct our lives. Colossians 4:6 says, "Let your speech (your words) be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man."

Words are your life.

There's a spiritual language for Christians, which is why, as a child of God, you should speak the Word of God, because the supernatural life is based on your word. Your tongue rules your life. "Your life today is the harvest of all the words you've been speaking. Therefore, always speak righteousness, peace, health, wealth, and joy."
