FROM THE MINISTER'S DESK.
THE WEEKLY MEDITATION.
SUNDAY 21ST — SATURDAY 27TH APRIL, 2024.

THEME: SHAKE IT OFF THE TEXT: JUDGES. 20:22

"And the people, that is, the men of Israel, encouraged, themselves and again formed the battle line at the place where they had put themselves in array on the first day".

Everything life throws at you will either make you stronger or make weaker. The challenges you face in life are not determinants to what life holds for you, rather what is most important is the attitude with which we approach the problem. Many people including believers have become victims of their own exaggerations and are still suffering from it.

Don't empower your problems, don't give them wings to fly, don't elevate them beyond what they are, don't make a mountain out of an ant hill, you have the sole right to decide what interpretation you give to whatever challenge you face in life. Apostle Paul, could have become withdrawn, been disturbed, fretful and sick as someone who has just suffered from shipwreck and bitten by a viper, but he shook off the negative thoughts thrown at him just the same way he shook the viper into the fire.

Do not count your problems, recount God's promises. Do not let the comments of those who seem to hate you determine your countenance or expression. Don't let the negative words, comments, situations thrown at you make you depressed and discontented to the extent that you begin to doubt the grace of God. Shake it off! The Word of God is true and can never lie, therefore, you have a glorious tomorrow. Your second half shall surely be better than the first. People may gloat over you with the intention to weigh you down, but remember that you are a Covenant Child of God so shake off the negative and fill it up with positive.
